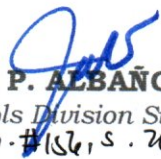
1. Each year, on **1 December**, the world commemorates World AIDS Day. People around the world unite to show support for people living with HIV and to remember those who have died from AIDS-related illnesses. The theme for WAD 2025 is, "Overcoming disruption, transforming the AIDS response." The theme highlights the challenges faced by the global HIV/AIDS response due to factors like funding cuts and punitive laws, while calling for a renewed, transformative approach to end the epidemic by 2030.
2. The field is requested **to hold related activities on December 1-15, 2025** through the following, but not limited to:
 - a. Online and public display of World AIDS Day (WAD) 2025 banner
 - b. Use of a customized profile frame: Access the frame at <https://twb.nz/wadph2025>. Download your photo with frame and upload it to your social media accounts.
 - c. AIDS walk
 - d. Use of hashtags **#WADPH2025 #WorldAIDSDay2025 #EndAIDS** and **#OKSaDepEd** when posting pictures and sharing content in an online platform
 - e. Online or face-to-face HIV/AIDS educational talks and sessions that will keep attendees engaged:
 - Creation of quizzes and questionnaires
 - Encourage participants to ask questions
 - Provision of merch, if available

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4. In addition, attached herewith is the list of schools and schedule of HIV/AIDS Symposium and voluntary HIV testing/ screening to be conducted by the City Health Office staff. The schools are to prepare the venue, participants and sound system.
5. School heads, ADAS/COS, School ARH Focal person (Clinic Teachers/ Guidance Advocates) shall spearhead the conduct of the activity. Reporting of the said activity will be done through the **online ARH Accomplishment Reporting under ARH Advocacies Template link shared to ARH Focal Persons/COS/ADAS group chat in messenger on or before December 15, 2025.**
6. Expenses incurred relative to the conduct of the activity shall be charged to school MOOE following the usual accounting rules, regulations, and procedures.

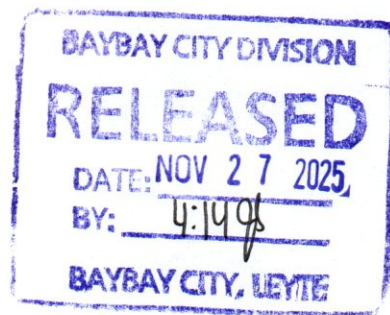
